


- Electricity use down 5%

2040 Target -Fleet









As of April 2025:

- 55% of NHS cars are electric
- 35% of NHS vans are electric
- Over 1700 electric vehicles in total



Fleet – notable successes



Orkney – 100% electric fleet

Ayrshire & Arran – 94% electric car fleet

Forth Valley – 91% electric cars & 78% electric vans (72)

Lanarkshire – 93% electric vans

Shetland – 95% electric cars
































2040 Target - Inhaler Propellant












5% more inhalers being prescribed

Plastic Minor Tray

Instrument Reduction 29% 31 to 22

Single Use Plastic Reduction 33%

Tray Size reduction 50% From 60x60 to 30x60

Associated Cost Avoidance £32,208 Annually

Associated Carbon Avoidance 1249 kg/CO2e
